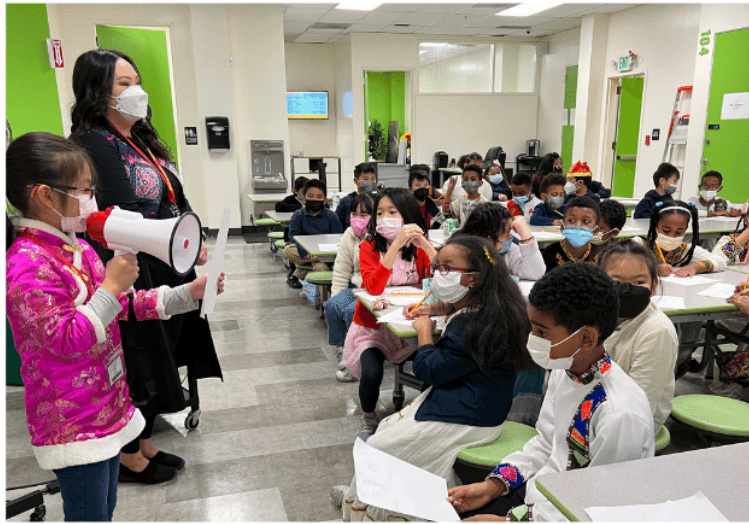

Illuminate & Scholastic Benchmarks: Gauging Student Progress

 **AIMS Benchmarks: Assessing Student Progress** This month, we wrapped up our 2nd round of Benchmarks. These benchmarks are used by teachers to see how they are doing at this time of the year. The students have been studying and trying their best to master the standards. This will help us create different plans to help all of our students grow.

 **Testing Score Improvement: Collaboration Yields Results** AIMS noticed a significant increase in Benchmark 2 testing scores following professional development with teachers over the Benchmark 1 reports. Mr. Ahmad from Data and Academic Performance, worked with Ms. Glass, the Director of Schools, Ms. Wells, the Instructional Coach, and School sites to go over the strengths and weaknesses of student performance with the teachers, and they were able to pinpoint areas they could assist students with improvement.

In honor of Black History month, we hosted the HBCU caravan which was a success!

- Hosted the Airforce last month with a great turnout.
- Had Genesys works presented to our 11th-grade students to offer them a paid internship with a value of 15,000 for their senior year. with a top technology company in the Bay Area.
- Students are still working hard to finish their FAFSA. I am so proud of the resiliency and the determination of our Seniors. Our students come from such a diverse background including some with undocumented status who have had to deal with major glitches and issues with filling out the FAFSA and adjusting to the new protocols and rules. Despite the system's setbacks our students continue to persevere.
- In College Planning our seniors are learning how to write formal research papers and are working hard on their senior projects. This year the senior projects include a 4 page research paper, 10 hours of fieldwork experience and a 4-6 minute presentation in May.
- Students continue to receive college acceptances from the CSU system and are gearing up for the major College admissions season starting in March.
- In March our K-5 will participate in a College Awareness month which AIMS to bolster college awareness among our youngest students.

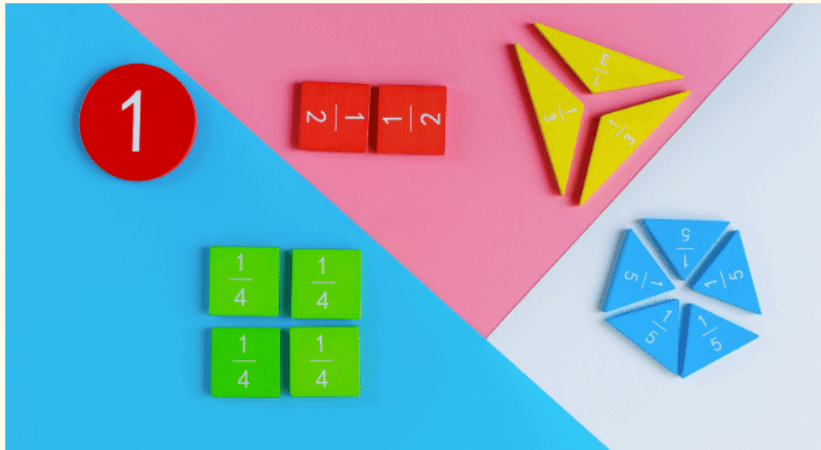

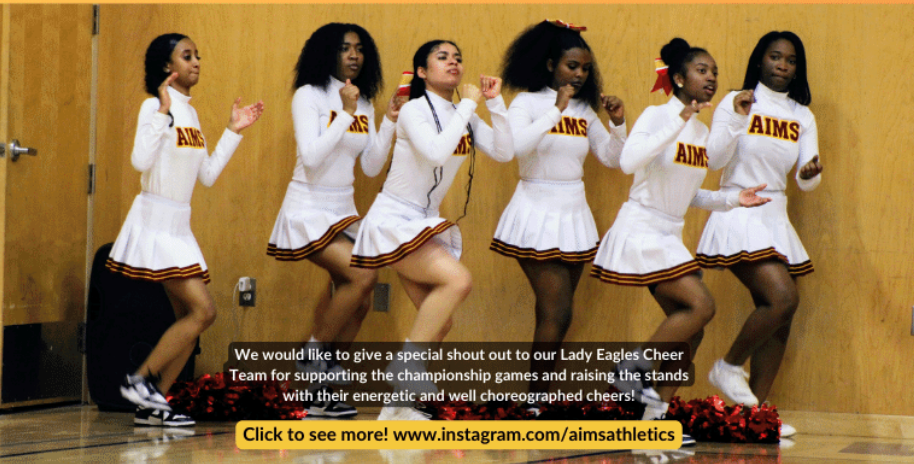


Golden Eagles vs. Twin Oaks

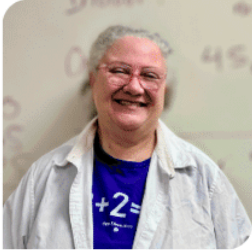

Ms. Spencer, Math and Science Teacher since 2013, explores what initially drew her to AIMS District and why she decided to stay.

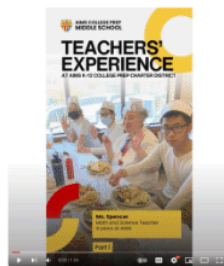
"I'd say the culture has been high expectations, both of the teachers and the students. It has been hard work is valued, effort is valued, and dignity is valued."

BLACK HISTORY MONTH CELEBRATION!

AIMS celebrated Black History Month with a HBCU College Expo, a celebration filled with exciting performances, a door decorating contest, and a visit to the Museum of Children's Arts to explore Afro Futurism.

AIMS high school hosted the HBCU caravan, with representatives from over 30 historically black colleges and universities in attendance. Students were able to connect with their dream schools and ask all of their questions about the universities, college culture, and academics. The Expo resulted in 10 on the spot acceptance and almost \$300,00 in scholarships awarded!



At the Black History Month celebration, high school and middle school students came together to celebrate black culture. The middle school Jazz Ensemble performed Kansas City Blues and Motown and high school students sang a beautiful rendition of "Lift Your Voice." Students introduced Black change-makers, innovators, and artists in a series of skits and performed a dance routine.
