

- All other students residing outside of OUSD

### How does the lottery work? / 抽籤如何運作?/¿Cómo funciona la lotería?/

- Applications that were received by the deadline of February 16 2024 are included in this lottery
- An algorithm determines eligible students by the school's priorities
- Priorities are verified by the enrollment team
- The system sorts the individuals by the priority preferences and then randomly sorts each group to produce the lottery results.
- Staff is unable to make changes to the lottery as it is randomly generated by the system.



### How does the waitlist work?/候补名单如何运作?/¿Cómo funciona la lista de espera?

- If your child is not accepted they will be automatically placed on the waitlist.
- The waitlist is generated randomly by the system.
- Placement on the waitlist is based by the school's priorities.
- Staff is legally not allowed to alter anyone's numerical placement on the waitlist. We have to follow the waitlist.
- Waitlist will change based on the applicant's priorities.
